In 2019, Asia Art Archive launches new collections and initiatives around performance art as an area of focus. Performance is a time-based, ephemeral art form that presents challenges for documentation. AAA launched the archive of the pioneering performance artist Lee Wen, who passed away in March 2019. Through his important contributions to the field, AAA opens new ways of thinking about performance art for the region and beyond. To bring more depth to the understanding of the art form, AAA also hosted exhibitions, public and educational programmes that look at the evolution of performance art in Asia.

The Annual Fundraiser is the most important source of support for Asia Art Archive, which raises more than half of the organisation's operating budget.
